**Glossary of terms**

*Schedule 1 Birds -All naturally occurring wild birds in Great Britain are protected from persecution. It is illegal to kill, injure or 'take' any wild bird, take or damage the nest of any wild bird whilst in use or being built. The eggs of all wild birds are also protected. If you have in your possession any live wild birds, egg(s) or any part of a wild bird you are committing an offence. The birds listed in this Schedule are further protected by Special Penalties all year round for those in Part 1 and during a specified closed season for those listed in Part 2.*

*RSPB Red List Birds -The UK's birds can be split in to three categories of conservation importance - red, amber and green. Red is the highest conservation priority, with species needing urgent action.*

Red list criteria:

- Globally threatened
- Historical population decline in UK during 1800-1995
